VISUAL AIDS COMES TO SAN DIEGO

Visual AIDS utilizes art to fight AIDS by provoking dialogue, supporting HIV+ artists, and preserving a legacy, because AIDS is not over. It is the only arts organization fully committed to raising AIDS awareness and creating dialogue around HIV issues by producing and presenting visual art projects, exhibitions, public forums and publications - while assisting artists living with HIV/AIDS. Escondido and San Diego Premiere Visual AIDS: POSTCARDS FROM THE EDGE

With the collaborative effort to bring A Day With(out) Art's premier film screening to San Diego this year, local artists Patrick Brown and Patric Stillman are heading up a west coast edition of Visual AIDS long running Postcards from The Edge. POZabilities is honored to sponsor this event.

Since 1998, Visual AIDS has produced the annual exhibition by established and emerging artists. Locally postcards will sell for \$75; one third of the proceeds will be utilized to produce "A Day With(out) Art", while another third goes to local HIV+ artists selected by Escondido Arts Partnership and The Studio Door, and the remaining third will be sent to benefit the programs of Visual AIDS in New York.

Postcards From the Edge offers a unique opportunity for buyers to acquire original, postcard-sized artwork offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Each piece is exhibited anonymously, and the iden-



tity of the artist is revealed only after the work is purchased. With the playing field leveled, all participants can take home a piece by a famous artist, or one who's just making their debut in the art world. Nonetheless, collectors walk away with something beautiful, a piece of art they love!

San Diego Premiere DAY WITH(OUT) ART: ALTERNATE ENDINGS, RADICAL BEGINNINGS

In conjunction with Visual Aids 28th Day With(out) Art

ALTERNATE ENDINGS, RADICAL BEGINNINGS seeks to highlight the voices of those that are marginalized within broader Black communities nationwide, including queer and trans folks.

In spite of the impact of HIV/AIDS within Black communities, these stories and experiences are constantly excluded from larger artistic and historical narratives. In 2016 African Americans represented 44% of all new HIV diagnoses in the United States. It is increasingly urgent to feature a myriad of stories that consider and represent their lives.



The commissioned projects include intimate meditations of young HIV positive protagonists; a consideration of community-based HIV/AIDS activism in the South; explorations of the legacies and contemporary resonances within AIDS archives; a poetic journey through New York exploring historical traces of queer and trans life, and more. Together, the videos provide a platform centering voices deeply impacted by the ongoing epidemic.


